CNA Student Agreement

Costs related to CNA Training and Certification

To provide a perspective for applicants, the financial obligation on the following chart is a breakdown of 2021 costs (**subject to change***) associated with the CNA apprenticeship.

	Approximate Costs*
MATC CNA class application fee	\$ 30.00**
Castlebranch Electronic Health Record***	\$107.00
MATC Admin, Student ID and parking fees	\$ 30.00
Book, for MATC CNA class	\$ 68.30
Nursing Scrubs	\$ 53.00
CNA exam	\$125.00
Gait belt	\$ 10.00
Student/Parent Out-of-pocket expenses	(<i>approximate</i>) \$423.30

* **Note:** Ozaukee Youth Apprenticeship (OYA) covers the cost of the CNA class

** The CNA class application fee is waived until May 2021

*** Castlebranch costs provided above only include the CBC and drug screen costs. Other testing (TB test, flu shot & physical) are also required and would be the responsibility of the student/family and may be covered by insurance. These costs will vary per provider and the student's insurance plan.

CNA course locations (i.e., technical colleges and other sites) may have requirements for enrollment in their CNA course. These may include the student's GPA, transcripts or ACT, SAT or other placement scores.

Families experiencing financial hardships with respect to the above out-of-pocket costs can contact the OYA office.

CNA Contract Agreement

- ❖ I have read the information related to the costs for pre-requisite training to obtain the necessary certification to become a Certified Nursing Assistant Apprentice through the Ozaukee Youth Apprenticeship program.
- ❖ I am aware the students is responsible for successful completion of the required CNA training to become a Nursing Assistant Youth Apprentice.
- ❖ I am aware Ozaukee Youth Apprenticeship will pay the cost of the CNA Course tuition. The balances of the costs are the responsibility of the student/parent or guardian.
- ❖ I understand that if my child is applying for a Health Youth Apprenticeship they may be required to be bonded and may be asked by the employer about their background. The Wisconsin Caregiver Law requires background and criminal history checks of certain personnel who are responsible for the care, safety and security of children and adults including students in the YA Health Sciences program.
